Summary of Complaints/Incidents:

BPC's 2024 Enforcement Protocol, Section 6(b) requires that "patterns of repeat offenses by the same entity shall be presented to the Board prior to negotiating an administrative consent agreement." The companies below have been determined to have made repeat offenses:

TruGreen: Three incidents after last approved consent agreement

On June 5, 2026, BPC received a complaint from a member of the 2026 Maine Pesticide Notification Registry alleging that they were not notified in advance of an application taking place that day to a neighbor's property, and that the applicator did not post the lawn after the application. A Board pesticide inspector was able to confirm the lack of posting on June 5, 2026. During an inspection with the company on June 10, 2026, the applicator said he was not aware that there was a member of the Registry next door. The manager said they were not able to provide evidence that a notification was made because notifications were handled by the corporate office, but that he would start handling notifications personally and would use a spreadsheet to keep track of notifications going forward.

On June 16, 2026, BPC received a complaint from a homeowner alleging that an authorized pesticide application was conducted on their lawn without consent. They believe the application was supposed to take place on their neighbor's lawn, but the applicator did not confirm the address. A BPC pesticide inspector conducted an inspection with TruGreen on June 18, 2026, confirming that the application was made to the wrong house on June 16, 2026. The applicator knocked on the door, which nobody answered, but proceeded with the application regardless. The inspector also confirmed that the application was not posted.

On July 7, 2026, BPC received a complaint from a homeowner alleging drift from a neighbor's property that was treated by TruGreen some weeks before the complaint. The BPC pesticide inspector was not able to confirm drift, but during the course of the inspection, the inspector revealed that an application had been conducted on April 10, 2026, by TruGreen applicator Abraham Lincoln even though Mr. Lincoln's license had been terminated on December 31, 2024. The TruGreen branch manager explained that there had been miscommunication between him and BPC staff and that Mr. Lincoln's license shouldn't have been terminated. Nevertheless, the matter was not resolved, and Mr. Lincoln continued making pesticide applications for TruGreen until shortly after the April 10, 2026, application.

Of the three 2026 incidents summarized above, one occurred on the same day that the Board approved a consent agreement with TruGreen at the June 5, 2026, Board meeting. The consent agreement was for a misapplication to the wrong address in 2025.

Summary of Relevant Rules and/or Laws:

Failure to notify a person on the Maine Pesticide Notification Registry is a violation of CMR 01-026, ch. 28, Section 2 (D) (5), which requires commercial pesticide applicators making outdoor, non-agricultural pesticide applications within 250 feet of the property boundary of a participant of the Pesticide Notification Registry to notify the participant between 6 hours and 14 days prior to the pesticide application.

Failure to notify a person that requested notification under CMR 01-026, ch. 28, Section 1 is a violation of CMR 01-026, ch. 28, Section 1(B), which requires commercial pesticide applicators making outdoor, non-agricultural pesticide applications within 500 feet of a sensitive area, such as a house, to notify the requestor at least one day before any pesticide application is to occur.

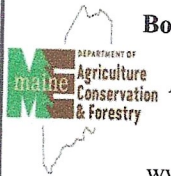
The unauthorized application is a violation of 01-026 C.M.R. ch. 20, Section 6(D)(2).

The failure to implement a system, based on Board-approved methods, to positively identify the property of their customers is a violation of 01-026 C.M.R. ch. 20, Section 7(A).

Failure to comply with posting requirements after an application is a violation of CMR 01-026, ch. 28, Section 3(B).

Making unlicensed commercial pesticide applications is a violation of Maine statute, 22 M.R.S. § 1471-D (1).

Brief Summary of Inspection

On 6/10/2026 a non-agricultural follow up use inspection was conducted with applicator Craig Stanley and Manager Nick Greer, at 65 Gray Rd in Falmouth. This inspection was completed as a follow up to the complaint filed in COMPLAINT-22093, alleging missed notification to member of notification registry and application site not posted.

I visited the application site on 6/5/2026 after receiving the complaint and did not see any posting.

On 6/5/2026, applicator Craig Stanley made an application of Escalade 2 EPA Reg. No. 228-442 to 16 Sea Garden Circle in Kennebunk to control weeds. Application rates, methods, and targets were consistent with product labels. Records were missing applicator license number and sky conditions, this was discussed at the inspection and followed up with additional compliance assistance via email.

Stanley said he did not know there was a member of the notification registry next door. Manager Nick Greer said that notifications are done in the corporate office but since this incident he has taken over making notifications. He could not produce proof that an effort to notify had been made, he has started a spreadsheet that he will use to keep track of notifications going forward.

Stanley confirmed that the application site was not posted when he left. He said he was writing the sign to post when the complainant came running up to him and yelling. He said he got scared and left the site at that time. Stanley is a new applicator this year and said he didn't know what to do. I recommended he post the site before starting the application in the future to make sure there was always posting when he left and no one would enter a recently treated area without knowing.

In a follow up email to Nick Greer, I sent a copy of Ch. 50 Record Keeping and Reporting Requirements, Ch. 20 Special Provisions with positive identification of a treatment site section highlighted, and Ch. 28 Notification Provisions for Outdoor Pesticide Applications.

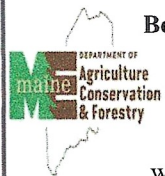

Summary of Interview with Complainant
Visited Martha Adjutant at 947 Cape Rd in Limington in response a complaint reporting an application on the incorrect property, COMPLAINT-23104. Adjutant said that her neighbor across the street at 948 Cape Rd is a client of TruGreen but her property is all organic. She had concerns about the birds and pollinators on her property and the safety of the food in her garden. Adjutant was not home at the time of the application but did have surveillance video showing the applicator driving around the property on a spreader. Light colored granular partials could be seen across the property grounds.

In the surveillance video the applicator can be seen applying around the food garden but no application was made in the garden, the garden plants also had their ground covered with plastic.

There was not sign left posting the property after the application.

A service ticket at left at the door with the product information, her address listed as the application site and her neighbors address as the mailing address.

Brief Summary of Inspection

On 6/18/2026 a non-agricultural follow-up use inspection was conducted with Mustafa Mohammad, applicator for TruGreen and Manager Nick Greer. This inspection was conducted in response a complaint reporting an application on the incorrect property, COMPLAINT-23104.

The TruGreen client lives at 948 Cape Rd in Limington; the service records had 948 Cape Rd as the mailing address but listed 947 Cape Rd as the property to be serviced. Greer believed the client had signed up for a new service and the address got inputted incorrectly by the sales team. Mohammad admitted that he applied to 947 Cape Rd, he said he did not know the property was not the client. He said he knocked on the door and got no answer and then proceeded with the application.

On 6/16/2026, applicator Mustafa Mohammad made an application of 0-0-7 .067% Acelepryn insecticide EPA Reg. No. 100-1492-9343, to 947 Cape Rd in Limington to control grubs. Records were missing applicator license number and sky conditions. Mohammad did not leave any sign to post the area after the application.

Greer provided the coordinates they had in their system for this property, coordinates show the incorrect property at 947 Cape Road. Applicators do not have access to these coordinates unless they call the manager in the office to request them. There were no other methods for positive identification for this site.

Recommendations

Complaint: Unauthorized application on the incorrect property

Violations noted: Unauthorized pesticide application on the incorrect property, property not posted after application, missing information in records.

Brief Summary of Inspection

Conducted a Records and Operations Check inspection with TruGreen applicator Donald Schmidt and manager Nick Greer on 7/9/2026 in response to a complaint filed under COMPLAINT-27110 received on 7/6/2026, with concerns of drift onto his property at 57 Oscar Littlefield Road in Lyman, spraying near a pond, and requesting notification for future applications.

The complainant was unable to recall the specific date of the application but stated that it had occurred a couple weeks prior to the complaint. Due to the length of time between the reported application and the inspection, no samples were collected.

Application records were obtained for pesticide applications conducted at 55 Oscar Littlefield Road on April 10, June 17, and June 22, 2026. Fertilizer application records were also obtained for applications conducted on April 24 and May 8, 2026. Based on the records reviewed, the applications were conducted in accordance with the applicable pesticide labels.

Some records were missing applicator license numbers, and all were missing sky conditions

The April 10, 2026 pesticide application was recorded as being conducted by Abraham Lincoln. Lincoln's applicator license had been terminated on December 10, 2024. TruGreen Manager Andrew Kozain had previously followed up on the license termination by email, indicating that Lincoln would be remaining with the company. Nick Greer stated that TruGreen did not receive a response to that communication. Lincoln had sufficient credits to renew his license; however, the license has remained terminated since 2024. Greer stated that Lincoln had not worked for TruGreen since shortly after the April 2026 application.

The most recent spray application was conducted by Donald Schmidt. I confirmed with Schmit using Google Earth imagery that he applied to the correct property. He said that he sprayed his back toward the neighboring property and was aware of the property line because of the fence. He said he did not spray much in the back yard where the water was and was sure to stay 25 feet away.

Schmidt also stated that he spoke with the homeowner at 55 Oscar Littlefield Road regarding the complaint. According to Schmidt, the homeowner stated that the complainant makes complaints whenever something occurs on her property.

I also contacted the homeowner at 55 Oscar Littlefield Road. She stated that she did not want to discuss the matter too much to avoid conflict with her neighbor. She reported that the neighbor had previously made complaints about her to the Town and that, in her experience, complaints occur whenever she does anything to her property.

Nick Greer confirmed that he had received the complainant's letter requesting notification prior to future pesticide applications. Greer stated that TruGreen would provide notification when the next application at the property is scheduled.

Recommendations

Unable to test for drift due to length of time since application until complaint was made. One application was made by unlicensed applicator and records were missing some information. No other violations were observed.
